

DOBRA NOTCH



Dobranotch is internationally acclaimed world music band originally from Saint Peterburg, Russia. They been a leading voice of klezmer revival from Former Soviet Union for more than 25 years. They mix klezmer (Eastern European Jewish), Balkan, Russian, Roma, Middle Eastern, Ukrainian and Caucasian traditional music, using also modern styles and rhythms, but preserving the acoustic sound of a traditional klezmer wedding orchestra.

Commencing their musical adventure as a wandering band on the streets of the French city of Nantes in 1998, they made their way to the major international festivals, such as

Ashkenaz (Canada),
Jewish Culture Festival Krakow (Poland),
Rudolstadt (Germany),
Andanças (Portugal)

in name of few.

Dobranotch have toured 30 countries and recorded 11 albums. Their music has been featured in films, documentaries and television films. Dobranotch have received such prestigious awards as

- Eiserner Eversteiner (Folkherbst winner) – Audience Choice Award, 2017
- German Record Critics Award – The Best Quarterly Folk and Singer/Songwriters Album, 3rd quarter 2019
- Russian World Music Award – The Best World Music Project, 2019

In the philharmonic hall they sound like refined artists, in a club or at a festival stage they send the audience into a dancing trance, and when they descend from the stage, they're the orchestra for a magic carnival.

Following the 2022 Russian invasion of Ukraine members of the group left Russia and moved to Germany to find new international line up.
